



Stain Removal

Got a stain emergency? Keep calm and don't panic. Our stain removal guide will get you through the tough times.

STEP 1 : Assess

Successful stain removal means using the right type of product on the appropriate surface. Once you know what you're dealing with, use the right product for the job. Clorox® Oxi Magic™ stain remover is safe for use on most surfaces, including:

- Laundry
- Carpets
- Bathtubs
- Sinks
- Countertops
- Toilets
- Vinyl and tile floors
- Tile and grout
- Shower curtains

Don't use Clorox® Oxi Magic™ on nylon, silk, wool, leather and on other surfaces damaged by water.

STEP 2: Identify

Once you know the type of surface you're working with, you need to know what stain you're up against. Clorox® Oxi Magic™ can work wonders if you're facing stains like:

- Coffee/tea
- Cosmetics
- Grape/berry juice
- Grease from food
- Ink
- Mechanical grease and oil
- Mud/dirt
- Red wine
- Soda
- Tomato sauce

STEP 3 : Test

Do a quick colorfast test to make sure that favorite shirt can take a stain removal solution.

1. Dissolve 1 teaspoon of Clorox® Oxi Magic™ stain remover powder in 1 cup of hot water. Or use Clorox® Oxi Magic™ stain remover spray.
2. Soak a hidden area of the garment in the powder solution for 1 minute. If using Clorox® Oxi Magic™ stain remover spray, apply to a hidden area of the garment and allow the product to sit for 5 minutes
3. Rinse and let dry.
4. The garment is safe for washing if the color does not fade or bleed.

STEP 4 : Apply the Magic

Make a stain removal solution using either Clorox® Oxi Magic™ stain remover powder or spray. Stand back and watch the stain disappear.

Spray

1. Soak up any excess liquid or residue from the stain.
2. Apply Clorox® Oxi Magic™ stain remover spray directly on the stain and rub it in gently.
3. Let stand 3 to 5 minutes.
4. Wash immediately with detergent in the warmest water the fabric will accept.

Powder

1. Dissolve 1/2 scoop of Clorox® Oxi Magic™ stain remover powder for each 1 cup of water used.
2. Soak up any excess liquid or residue from the stain.
3. Apply the solution to the stain and rub it in gently.
4. Allow to absorb for 5-30 minutes.
5. Rinse with water.
6. Soak up moisture with a towel or heavy cloth.
